# Curriculum Newsletter Term 3

### Literacy:

This term we will be reading 'The Pirates next door' by Jonny Duddle. We will be using adjectives to write sentences to describe both the characters and the pirate ship. We will continue to focus on saying our sentences before we write them and will use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will also be reading non-fiction texts about pirates and will write about Blackbeard, Anne Bonny and Grace O'Malley.

### Maths:

We will be learning about numbers to 20. We will represent numbers, find one more/less, order and compare numbers. We will also add and subtract within 20 using practical resources to help us.
