Literacy:

In our writing journeys we will study:

- · Biographies/autobiographies
- · Balanced arguments

In class we will be reading Secrets of a Sun King by Emma Carroll.

Numeracy:

We will begin the term developing our knowledge of decimals. We will multiply and divide decimals by 10, 100 and 1000. We will use our knowledge of division to solve problems. Next, we will move on to order and compare fractions, decimals and percentages. We will continue our learning to find percentages of an amount. Finally, we will develop our knowledge of algebra to form expressions. We will solve one and two step equations and find pairs of values.

Unit: Were the Ancient Egyptians achievers?
