Why do some people or animals move from one country to another, and what are some reasons they might decide to live in a new place?

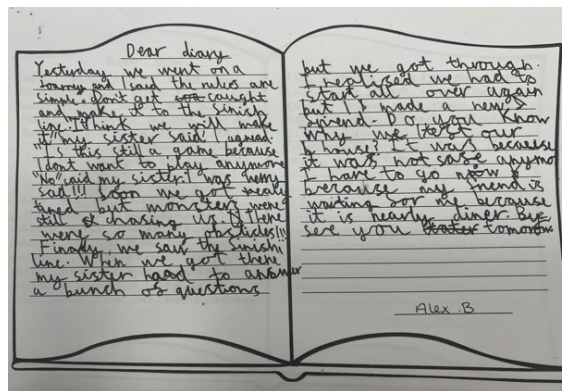
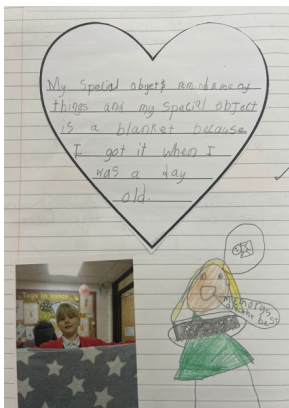
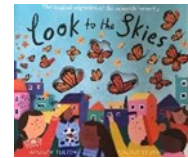
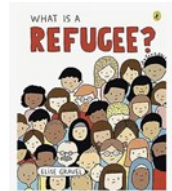
“Animals migrate because they need to go somewhere warmer”
