Curriculum Newsletter Summer Term 1

Literacy:

In our writing journeys we will study:

- Flashback story
- Holiday brochure
- Complaint writing

Numeracy:

We will be looking at statistics, including line graphs and pie charts. Then we will look at geometry, including properties of shapes. In preparation for our SATs we will continue to revise number and fraction, decimal and percentage topics. We will explore past arithmetic and reasoning papers to help prepare us for the exams that take place in May.

Computing:

We will be learning all about big data, including how data is collected and stored. We will explore barcodes, QC codes and RFID chips. We will learn the difference between mobile data and Wi-Fi and how data is transferred.

Unit: Where are we going?

Science: We will be studying evolution and inheritance. This will include investigating how things change over time, looking at fossils to find evidence of how things have changed and studying Darwin's theories.

Wider Curriculum:

In History, our studies will be themed around our science topic of evolution and inheritance. We will study key scientific figures in depth, including Charles Darwin, Mary Anning and Jean-Baptiste Lamarck, and their theories.

In Geography, we will explore global warming and what is happening as a result of this. We will discuss what might happen to the planet if we do nothing and see the effects on all living things and environments

In Art, we will be studying pop art, including artists such as Andy Warhol. We will produce our own pop art. We will continue learning Spanish words and phrases also.

Helping at home:

Spelling homework will be sent out on a **Monday** and maths homework will be sent out on **Friday**. Please ensure that your child is reading for 15/20 minutes every day and recording this in their reading record. Continued practise of all 12x12 times tables will help to support their mathematical understanding.

R.E:

We will be asking "does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives?"

PSHE: We will learn how to be proud of who we are. We will think about our feelings and how to step out of our comfort zone.
