We are excited to tell you about our **COLOR RUN** that will be taking place during the school day on **Friday 17th July**.

We are doing this as a sponsored event to help raise £3,741 for a set of i-pads, trolley and licences (we have already raised £1,759 this year! )

The Colour Run is a non-competitive, fun event where children walk, jog or run around our track while being gently showered with coloured powder at stations along the way. The emphasis is on participation, enjoyment and teamwork, not speed or distance.

#### How it will work

- Children will take part **by year group**, from Reception to Year 6
- Distances will be **age appropriate** so that all children can take part comfortably
- Children may **walk, jog or run** – it is not a race
- Staff and volunteers will be positioned around the course to support and encourage the children

All pupils will receive the same positive experience, regardless of how much or how fast they choose to move around the course.
