Year R- Cherry Class Unit: What lives in my Garden?



Mathematical Development:

In maths activities we will be focussing on-
Exploring different ways to build doubles using real objects and practical equipment.
Develop understanding of how to find number patterns sharing and grouping
Be able to talk about Even and Odd numbers
Deepening Understanding of numbers to 20
Continue to practise and consolidate key skills in subitising, composition, counting, sorting and matching and comparing and ordering numbers.

Personal Social and Emotional Development

In our Heartsmart lessons, we will talk about how making mistakes is important and helps us to learn.
The importance of keeping trying when something is difficult
Learn to express how we feel about change and talk about transition into Year 1

Expressive Art and Design:

We will develop our weaving skills and make large-scale weavings outside using natural materials and our own seascapes. We will make printing & rubbing patterns using every day natural objects.
In music we will be learning about what makes a musical instrument, the four different groups of musical instruments, following a beat using an untuned instrument and performing a practised song to a small audience.
