Literacy:

This term we are continuing to focus on non-fiction and fiction books written by British authors.

We will be focussing on Roald Dahl and will read *The Twits* and *George's Marvellous Medicine*. We will also look at Mairi Hedderwick and link this to our Science topic of materials.

Numeracy:

In maths we continue to follow the White Rose Scheme. We are focussing on telling the time up to five-minute intervals. We will also look at statistics and then position and direction. We will also be focussing on learning our 2,3, 5- and 10-times tables.

Computing:

We will continue to remember why we must be careful about who we talk to online. We will be learning Scratch. Exploring what 'blocks' do, using the app 'ScratchJr,' by carrying out an informative cycle of predict > test > review. We will programme a familiar story and an animation of an animal.

Wider Curriculum:

In PE we will be focussing on basketball and athletics where we will be improving our athletic abilities. In DT we will learn about British inventors such as Sir James Dewar, Charles Macintosh and Harry Brearly. We will link this to our knowledge of materials to help us design and make a flask to keep a drink hot and make a bird or bug box. In food technology we will make our own healthy dips and dippers. In science we will be looking at plants and materials. In History we will learn about the Great Fire of London. In Geography, we will be learning about the 4 countries that make up Great Britain.

Helping at home:

Children need to read at home everyday. Please fill in their reading records regularly. They will also bring home weekly spellings or phonics work which needs to be completed weekly. Please also log into TTRS to practice learning the times tables and Emile education to help with spellings.
