**Writing:** Year 5 will continue focusing on writing around the Romans in a range of roles such as recounts and documentaries in the form of a playscript. We will continue to work on ensuring spellings, punctuation and grammar are consistently accurately as well as writing for longer periods to improve stamina.

**Maths:** We will focus on converting between measurements using our knowledge of multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. Maple class will also look at co-ordinates, symmetry and translation of shapes on graphs.

### Wider Curriculum:
