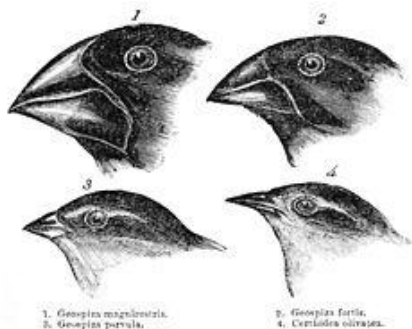




Curriculum Newsletter Summer Term 2

Year 6

Unit: Where are we going?

Literacy:

This term we will be continuing with writing 'Letter of complaints' and exploring the book 'War of the Worlds' by Russell Punter.

We will also be working towards creating our class yearbook to take home at the end of the term.

Numeracy:

As we have finished the maths curriculum, we will be looking at developing our ability to solve problems in context such as buying goods from a shop and the cost of household bills.

Computing:

We will continue to learn about the history of computers/computing and how technology continues to evolve and change within a relatively short period of time.

Science: This term we will be exploring living things and their habitats. We will learn about differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird. We will describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals. We will classify plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

Wider Curriculum:

In History, our studies will be themed around our science topic of evolution and inheritance. We will study key scientific figures in depth, including Charles Darwin, Mary Anning and Jean-Baptiste Lamarck, and their theories.

In Geography, we will learn about Global warming. Of course, we will also be preparing/rehearsing for our Y6 production of 'The Lion King'.

Helping at home:

Spelling homework will be sent out on a **Monday** and Maths homework will be sent out on **Friday**. Please ensure that your child is reading for 15/20 minutes every day and recording this in their reading record. Continued practise of all 12x12 times tables will help to support their mathematical understanding.
