

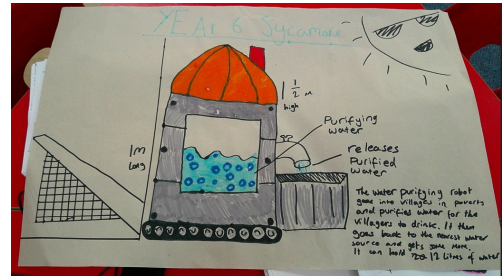
### A message from the Head of School to Parents...
